

# SNIFFABLE PRODUCTS

*Community stores can make a big difference in preventing sniffing*

## **AWARENESS**

Know which products in your store could be sniffed. Anything with a strong smell, vapour or aerosol spray is sniffable. Some common products are glue, spray paint, spray deodorant, nail polish and remover, fly spray and air freshener.

## **SAFE SALE**

The Volatile Substance Abuse Prevention (VSAP) Act 2005 supports stores in refusing sale by saying "No" to customers when you suspect someone could use a product for sniffing.

## **SAFE STORAGE**

Place sniffable products behind the counter, in a locked cabinet or out the back. This will help to prevent shoplifting and gives you a better chance to refuse sale. You can also use a Sales Record Form when you sell these products to keep tabs on the amount being sold to each customer.

## **PRODUCT ALTERNATIVES**

Find out about safer products to stock in your store, such as environmentally friendly insect repellants, safe formula spray paints, non-toxic glues and roll on deodorants.
